If you are moving (and you child is changing schools) please advise the office as soon as possible. Your cooperation greatly assists us in determining our




numbers and school organization for the upcoming school year. Please also ensure you have registered your child at your new catchment area

## SCHOOL REGISTRATION FOR SEPTEMBER 2022

Registration of course started in the new year. The following information will help determine if this process will apply to you.

# Take a moment and ask yourself the following questions:

- 1. Is my child new to Nanaimo-Ladysmith Public Schools?
- Do I have a child that will be turning five years old on or before December 31, 2021, that will be entering Kindergarten? Applications must be received by June 15<sup>th</sup> to ensure placement in your child's catchment-area school.
- Do I want to apply for a school transfer request (out-of-catchment)? Applications were due March 31<sup>st</sup>
